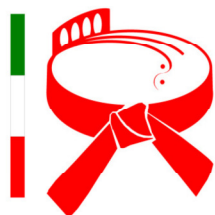


World Youth Karate Championships

1. General Information

The “**Internazionali Giovanili di Karate**” (International Youth Karate Competition), organized by the Unione Sportiva ACLI (hereafter USAcli) will take place **Sunday, March 18, 2012**, at the arena in Verona - Piazzale Azzurri D'Italia – near the Bentegodi stadium.

The competition will have only the **Kata** specialty.

The competition is open **to all young people enrolled in any Federation, Organization or Sport's Promotion Institution and to any style of Karate practitioners**, provided they have a membership card, insurance and compliant with health rules in force.

The competition includes both individual and team kata. Participants in the **individual competition** they will **be divided by gender and age** in the following **categories**:

Category A	(Up to 5 years)	Born after 2007
Category B	(6-7 years)	Born in 2007 or 2006
Category C	(8-9 years)	Born in 2005 or 2004
Category D	(10-11 years)	Born in 2003 or 2002
Category E	(12-13 years)	Born in 2001 or 2000
Category F	(14-15 years)	Born in 1999 or 1998
Category G	(16-17 years)	Born in 1997 or 1996

Participants will also be classified by color of belt as follows:

White	Yellow	Orange	Green	Blue	Brown	Black
Belts	Belts	Belts	Belts	Belts	Belts	Belts

If a participant wears a belt with two colored stripes will be enrolled in the highest degree (ie: An athlete with a yellow and white belt will compete in the category of yellow belts).

Up to the rank of brown belt participants can perform the kata Heian 1-5, Taikyoku Shodan (Shotokan), 5 Pinan (Wado Ryu and Shito Ryu), 3 and 2 Taikyoku Gekisai (Goju).

For black Belts kata can be chosen freely.

All athletes will perform 2 kata, is possible to repeat the same kata for two times.

Classifications will be made by adding the scores obtained in each trial. The age and grade of first three winners in each category will check (so they will show the proper documentation), and the organization's membership card in case of irregularity the participant will be disqualified and will take over the next ranked athlete.

In **team competition**, each team will consist of three athletes (**an athlete cannot be part of more teams**). The team will compete in the category of the athlete whose age and/or degree are greater than the others members (i.e.: 1 athlete Category A, 1 athlete Category B and 1 athlete Category C -> The team will be recorded in the Category C).

Teams can be mixed at any level. The teams, in addition to categories will be divided in two groups:

Group 1 White, yellow, orange and green belts

Group 2 Blue, Brown and black belts

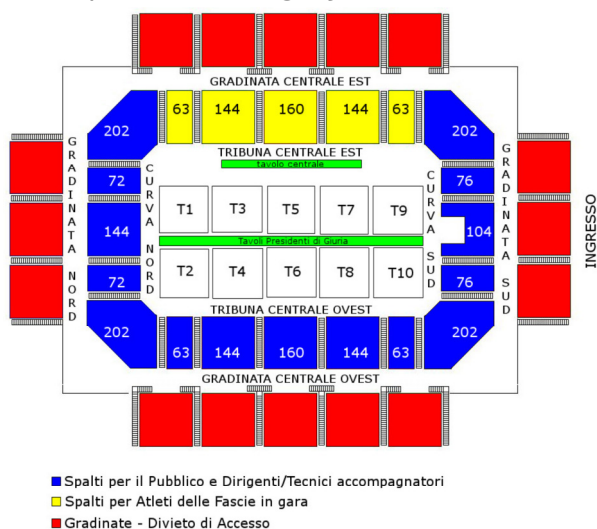
If a team is formed by 2 athletes belonging the Group 1 and the third one belonging the Group 2, the team

will compete in Group 2. (i.e.: 2 athletes orange belt and 1 athlete blue belt -> the team will be enrolled in the Group 2).

It's also present a **category dedicated to athletes with disabilities**, which would like to compete in individual Kata.

Prizes will be awarded to the top 4 finishers in each category and the top 8 clubs.

Only competing athletes can stay up on the competition field, the others must remain in the reserved areas in the stands waiting to be called.



The organization accepts no liability for any accident to persons or property before, during and after the event.

Upon registration each Association / Club will be responsible for ensuring that its participants are accompanied by the heads of the Association / Club itself, that comply with health regulations in accordance with the rules in force and whatever in the present regulation.

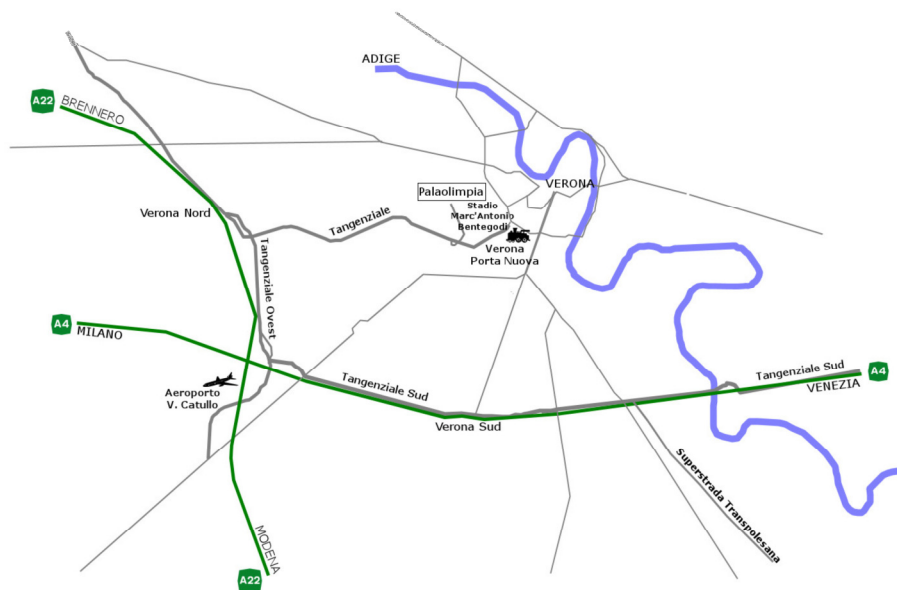
